My article for the December newsletter is being written as an update regarding the IBA camp.

First is a description of recent history. A specially appointed camp study team was appointed in April 2019 to study the history, current status and future of the camp with recommendations to be brought to the August 2019 meeting of the Executive Board of the Association. In summary, the results of their work led to the following recommendations: 1) The Association to divest our interest in the camp. 2) Proceeds from the divestment of the property be placed in an interest-bearing account to fund future student and family ministry within the Association. 3) Make every effort to see that the property remains in Kingdom work.

Second a special called Executive Board meeting was held 10 September 2019 for a vote to approve the recommendation. The motion for the association to divest our interest in the camp passed by 89% approval. This was followed by a motion for the Association Leadership Team to appoint a Divestment Team with authority to act on behalf of the Association to work through the process. The original Camp Study Team was asked to continue in this role. Four of the five agreed. When the fifth person felt unable to serve, the Association Moderator and Chairperson of the Association Leadership Team was asked and agreed to serve.

The Camp Divestment Team consists of Jerry Henderson, Newark, Greg Hodge, Emmanuel, Vicki Fitterling, Fellowship, Mike Fowler, Floral, Jeff Childers, Cord (Association Leadership Team, Chair), Aaron Leggett, (Association Moderator). This team has met twice over the past few weeks.

Finally, this team has agreed on the following:

- 1. The camp will be listed with an agent for sale. The agent will determine a value as a listing price.
- 2. Every effort will be made to honor the ministry history of the camp in the future. Thus, the property

will have a deed restriction that states the property will be sold to a Christian ministry.

- After ninety days, the team will evaluate activity of interest to determine if the deed restriction should be lifted.
- 4. Any proceeds from the sale of the camp will be placed in an interest-bearing account that protects the principal. Interest earned will be used to fund student and family ministry of the association.
- 5. Once a buyer is found, current occupants of the camp home will be given thirty days to find other accommodations.

While the work of the Camp Divestment Team is not complete, this team has worked prayerfully and thoughtfully in their assignment. This is not a task anyone is taking lightly, and each member recognizes the burden of responsibility placed in their care. They have sought to be sensitive in every way and honor the mandate of the original Camp Study Team.

We owe them a debt of gratitude and prayerful support as they continue in their work.
